**Meeting Called To Order**

Clerk Amy Patterson brought the Chase Township Board meeting to order at 7:30pm. Roll call shows Amy Patterson, Joyce Beach, and Janel Eichenberg present. Phil Lodholtz absent at roll call, came in at 7:37pm.

**Approval of Minutes**

Joyce Beach moved to approve the October 18, 2022 meeting minutes. Seconded by Janel Eichenberg. Motion passed unanimously.

**Treasurers Report**

*General Account*

Beginning balance October 2022 was \$391,982.93. Income received \$1,451.63. Expenses \$13,535.41. Leaving a balance of \$379,899.15.

*Library Account*

Beginning balance for October 2022 was \$91,039.47 Income received \$140.85. Expenses \$1,730.58. Leaving a balance of \$89,449.74.

*Tax Account*

Beginning balance for October 2022 was \$9,569.95. Income received \$3,863.73. Expenses \$12,421.13. Leaving a balance of \$1,012.55.

**Clerks Report**

Also looking into outfitting the library basement to be useable and fixing some shelving issues. Homeschool lunch bunch program is going well. The clasp on the front gates need to be fixed.

Amy Patterson gave update that the insurance company contacted her and they are sending a check for the items submitted to date.

Joyce Beach made a motion to buy a no dog's sign for the library playground area. Seconded by Amy Patterson. Motion passed unanimously.

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**New Business:**

*Winter tax bills-* Janel Eichenberg had issues with what she received from equalization the millages were not printing at all. Had to get ahold of BS&A to get it sorted out.

*Proposals-* Joyce Beach brought up the recently passed state proposals and was concerned with how they are going to impact the township financially. Amy Patterson mentioned that right now things are unclear on mandatory implementations but recommends going forward with a security camera system at the township hall and approved absentee ballot container as has been discussed in the past.

**Old Business**

*Large item drop off-* Waiting on a bill from Independent Rural Waste for the last large item drop off. There were about 55 loads from residents and filled one packer and part of a 2<sup>nd</sup> packer, and 2 roll off dumpsters. Would probably have a better turnout with more notice and a set date.
